How is ISN Different?

International School Nadi prepares students to be positive members of their communities and responsible global citizens. The school aims to develop values in children such as respect and understanding for other people's ideas, language and beliefs.

As an International Baccalaureate (IB) school, ISN encourages the education of the whole person through social, physical, emotional and cultural wellbeing thus establishing a foundation for lifelong learning.

In contrast to local public schools, ISN classes are much smaller, providing a greater focus on the progress and ultimate success of each individual student. The average class size in the Primary Years Programme (PYP) is 16; in the Middle Years Programme (MYP) 12; and in the Diploma Programme (DP) 10.

A dedicated primary years' Learning Support teacher and English as a Second Language options allow for an even greater level of preparedness for any learning challenges children might encounter.
