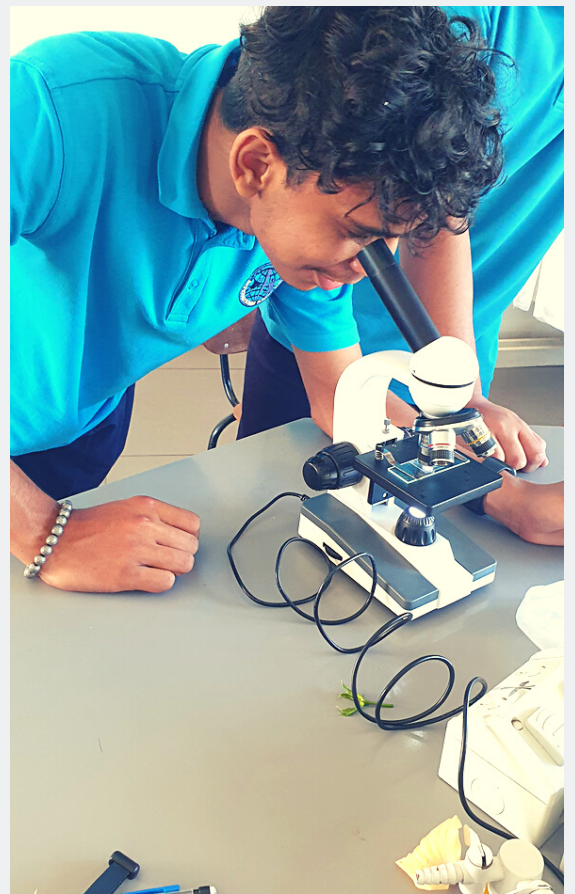

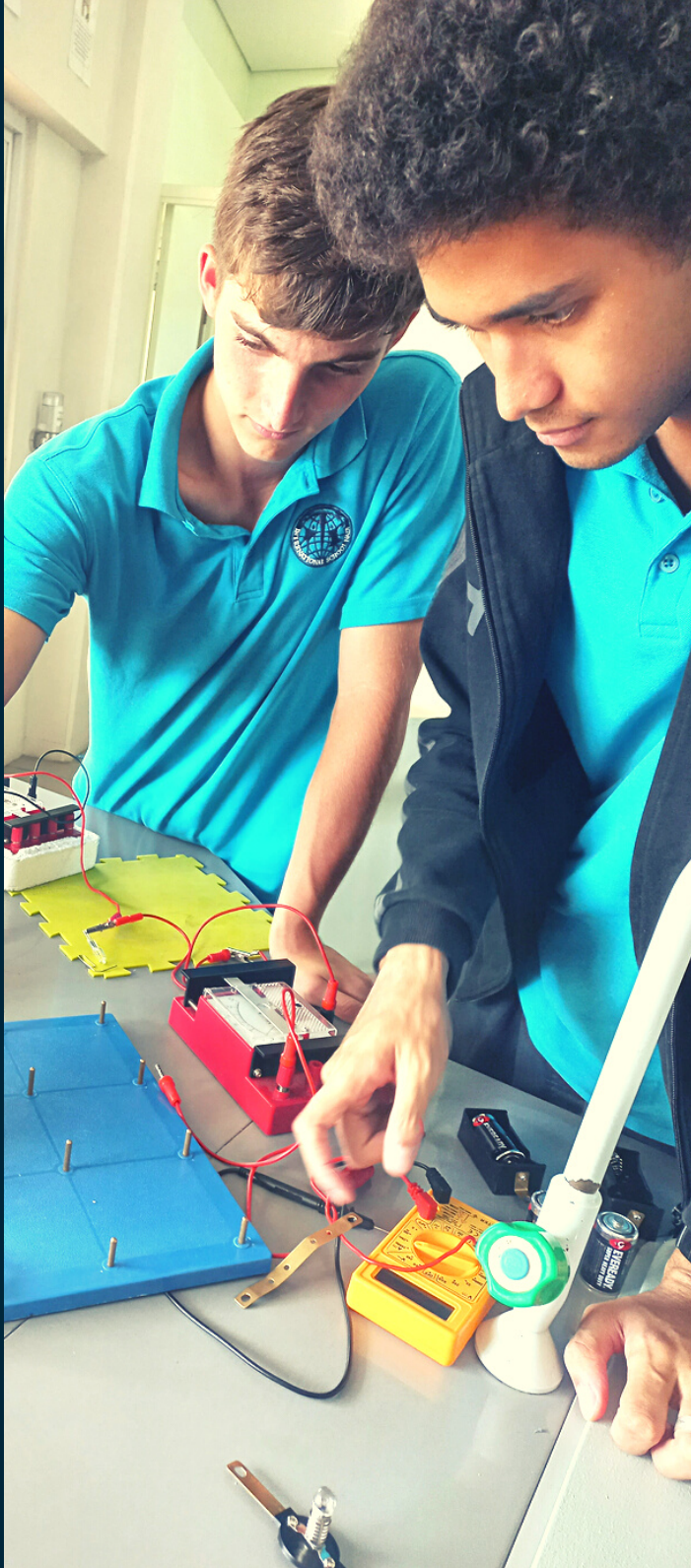

International School Nadi is a non-profit organisation that delivers the International Baccalaureate (IB) curriculum to children living in the Western Division of Fiji.

Our small school of 195 students educates children between the ages of 3 - 19 years old. Students and teachers come from countries all over the world including; Fiji, United States of America, United Kingdom, Canada, China, India, Japan, Korea, Italy, Mexico, Pakistan, South Africa, South Korea, Spain, Thailand, Sri Lanka, Tonga, Germany, New Zealand and Australia.

We provide quality education with high academic standards and an international focus. Essential school aims include:

Founded in 1968, the International Baccalaureate Organisation (IB) is a recognised leader in the field of international education, encouraging students to be active learners, well-rounded individuals and engaged world citizens. The IB currently works with 5,500 schools in 159 countries to develop and offer four challenging programmes to over 1.95 million students aged 3 to 19 years. International School of Nadi (ISN) is one of the few schools worldwide that exclusively offers the IB programme continuum:

- The Primary Years Programme (IB PYP) provides a coherent educational framework for students aged 3 to 12 that focuses on the development of the whole child in the classroom and in the world outside.
- The Middle Years Programme (IB MYP) is an international concept-based curriculum for students aged 11 to 16. It provides a framework of academic challenges that encourage students to become critical, reflective inquirers.
- The Diploma Programme (IB DP) is a rigorous, academically challenging and balanced programme of education designed to prepare students aged 16 to 19 for success at university and life beyond.

The IB Programmes focus holistically on the developing child, encompassing ethical, social, physical, emotional and cultural growth in addition to academic development. The programmes are designed to develop the knowledge, attitudes and skills necessary for students to become independent life-long learners able to participate actively and responsibly in a rapidly changing and increasingly interconnected world. Students are encouraged to celebrate and respect other cultures with the goal of promoting international mindedness.

As part of our continued effort to contribute to our local communities and to help develop our country's future leaders; International School Nadi is proud to offer partial and full scholarships to students born in Fiji.

We believe that a socially diverse school community is a key component of a balanced international education and one that can enrich the learning experiences of all of our students. The scholarship programme aims to give back to the local community by offering deserving students the opportunity to benefit from an IB education within a dynamic and inclusive environment regardless of their economic circumstance.

2024 SCHOLARSHIPS

International School Nadi offers full and partial scholarships to well rounded students who demonstrate academic potential and commitment to personal growth.

ISN would like to invite students who were born in 2009 to apply for a scholarship to enter our MYP4 class in January 2024. The school will support successful scholarship candidates for up to four years so that they can graduate with the internationally recognised IB Diploma.

Eligibility

In order to be eligible for a scholarship, candidates must:

- Be born in Fiji in 2009
- Be enrolling to International School Nadi for the first time. Current and former students of International School Nadi are not eligible to apply
- Be the appropriate age for the year level that they are applying for. Students younger than the stated age required for admission will not be considered, irrespective of the current level of studies being undertaken at another institution
- Have a total household income of \$60,000FJD or less (full scholarship only)

SELECTION CRITERIA & RENEWAL

Selection Criteria

Academic potential will be the primary determinant for awarding scholarships. This will be assessed based on the student's school reports from their past school and their performance on a MAP growth test which will be administered by the school. Extracurricular engagement such as sports and creative pursuits, commitment to community service and leadership experience will also be taken into account.

Scholarship Renewal

International School Nadi is committed to supporting students who have been awarded a scholarship until they graduate from the IB Diploma programme. Scholarships will be reviewed on an annual basis and will be continued into the next year as long as the student meets the requirements for renewal. Scholarship renewals will be communicated in writing before the end of each academic year.

In order for scholarships to be renewed students must:

- Maintain an excellent punctuality and attendance record. Students are expected to maintain an attendance record of 90% or higher
- Abide by all school rules and demonstrate qualities that are consistent with the IB learner profile
- Complete set work in a timely manner and in accordance with the school's Academic Integrity Policy
- Demonstrate ongoing commitment to community service through active participation in the MYP Service as Action or DP Creativity Activity Service Programmes
- Meet the minimum grade requirements on the Semester Two school reports. MYP scholarship students must achieve a minimum total of 40 points in their 8 academic subjects with no grade lower than a 4 in any subject. DP scholarship students must achieve a minimum total of 30 points from 6 academic subjects with no grade lower than a 4 in any subject.

Progress towards meeting the academic requirements for scholarship renewal will be reviewed and communicated to scholarship candidates following the release of the Semester One reports.

APPLICATION PROCESS

International School Nadi encourages applications from students who demonstrate academic potential and a commitment to personal growth beyond the classroom. Candidates can submit their applications via Google Forms or as a hard copy.

Applications must be submitted by no later than midnight, Friday 15th September 2023.

<p>Step 1 Applications to be submitted by no later than Friday 15th September</p>	<p>Candidates will be invited to submit an application for the scholarship. Applications should include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Scholarship Application Form• Photocopy of birth certificate• Photocopies of school reports for last two academic years• Recommendation letter from a member of staff at the candidate's current school• Personal statement: students must write a personal statement explaining why they are applying for the scholarship and what makes them suitable for a scholarship. This could include information on personal dispositions, academic achievements, engagement in extracurricular activities such as creative arts or sports, leadership experience and volunteer work (maximum 500 words)• Essay response: students must write a response to the following prompt: <i>"Describe a major challenge that you have faced and what you did to overcome it. Explain the impact that this had on you and how it shaped who you are today"</i>
<p>Step 2 Shortlisting</p>	<p>Shortlisted candidates will be screened for eligibility based on the application documents that have been submitted.</p>
<p>Step 3 Candidate Assessment & Interview</p>	<p>Shortlisted candidates will be invited to the school to attend an interview and to complete MAP Growth Assessment tests in Mathematics, Reading and Language Usage. Candidates will need to pay a non-refundable fee of \$65 FJD to cover the cost of the testing.</p>
<p>Step 4 Candidate Selection & Notification</p>	<p>Candidates will be assessed by the Scholarship Committee. Successful candidates will receive a formal written offer of a scholarship. This will include an outline of the terms and conditions of the scholarship in addition to a breakdown of any applicable fees. Students must sign the Letter of Acceptance within 5 working days to finalise the scholarship process.</p>

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Shortlisted scholarship candidates will need to pay a non refundable fee of \$65FJD in order to complete the MAP Growth assessments
- The decision of the Scholarship Selection Committee is final
- The scholarship is aimed at new students which means that currently enrolled or former students of International School Nadi are not eligible to apply
- Students whose school fees are paid by parents' companies cannot be considered for the Scholarship Programme.
- The school reserves the right not to offer a scholarship if no applicants meet the criteria
- Scholarship availability is dependent on the current enrollment numbers in each cohort. If a cohort is almost at full capacity the school may be unable to offer a scholarship for that year
- As per the school admissions policy, scholarship recipients must reside with a parent/guardian aged 21 or over
- The school reserves the right to withdraw the scholarship effective immediately if the student is found to be in breach of school rules or has falsified information on their application documents
- The school reserves the right to make amendments to the Scholarship Policy without prior notice
- Any applicable school fees must be paid by the fees deadline. Payment plans may be available at the discretion of the school Principal.

In addition to this form scholarship applicants must submit the following documents:

- Photocopy of birth certificate
- Photocopies of school reports for the last two academic years
- Recommendation letter from a member of staff at the candidate's current school
- Personal statement: write a personal statement explaining why you are applying for the scholarship and what makes you suitable for a scholarship. This could include information on personal dispositions, academic achievements, engagement in extracurricular activities such as creative arts or sports, leadership experience and volunteer work (maximum 500 words)
- Essay response: write a response to the following prompt: "Describe a major challenge that you have faced and what you did to overcome it. Explain the impact that this had on you and how it shaped who you are today" (maximum 500 words)

The application form and the accompanying documents must be submitted by no later than midnight Friday 15th September.
