The successful candidate will be required to teach Secondary Mathematics and/or Physics to students with a diverse range of interests and abilities. The role involves planning and delivering engaging, inquiry-based lessons that develop student understanding and curiosity in the subject area. The teacher will assess student progress using a variety of methods and use this data to differentiate instruction and meet individual learning needs. The candidate will also contribute to the wider school community through involvement in extracurricular activities, school events, and educational excursions that support a well-rounded student experience.

About the School

Established in 1992, International School Nadi is an independent, coeducational, non-profit school for students aged 3-18 years. As an International Baccalaureate (IB) Continuum School, our accredited IB Primary Years, Middle Years and Diploma programmes aim to develop our students into resilient, empathetic and inquisitive individuals who think critically and creatively, with the courage and conviction to take positive action locally and globally.
